Please send photos in PPE and contact Rachel if you want to volunteer for the member spotlight article. There was a discussion about 5 editions of bulletin versus 6. Dr. Bruce Terry said bylaws may dictate how many bulletins, and the benefit of 6 is more contact with members. Decided to stick to 6 bulletins/year. He also suggests a case study or pathology study as an article suggestion. Discussed member spotlight in bulletin. Dr. Jay Freedman suggests to start with a board member, new dentist, and seasoned dentist.

- 1. All Day CE Full day CE with Rachel Wall is on 9/25. The plan is for it to be outside, however, the meeting is capped at 25 because that's the limit for inside. Dr. Tom Howley says for the Nov. 13 CE, we have more than 25 people registered. We will need to decide what to do if the weather is bad. If CE is cancelled due to bad weather and too many people registered, we will owe money to the venue. Possible to add a Zoom component to CE? Will have to check with the speaker. Can't do all virtual because we have contracts with the venue for both events. Jessie plans to discuss with Nuri adding a virtual component or just making the events virtual, but will plan to keep contracts in the spring.
- 2. Distinguished Speakers Series/Evening CE Dr. Nancy Rosenthal asks if we would discount membership to PDA if the Monday night dinner/CE no longer exists because of zoom meetings. Consensus is no, but Dr. Tom Howley suggests giving 2 free dinners next year. Dr. Dave Kaffey suggests a free virtual CE rather than dinner, as opposed to changing due structure.
- 3. **Sponsorship Fellowship** Dr. Andrew. Steinkeler reports that only a few sponsors have issues with in person events. For 9/21, there are 2 confirmed sponsors with 2 more likely to sign up. Same with 9/25. Discussed a need to find ways to maximize virtual sponsorship.

The board discussed a NYC trip, and asked if it is too soon to plan a trip for the spring. It was decided that it is worth revisiting next fall or spring.
