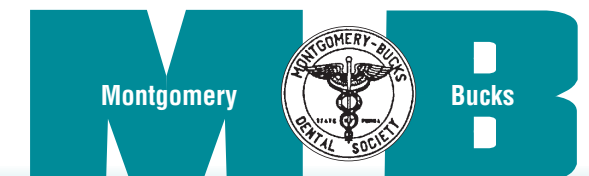

Seminar #1 Friday, October 23, 2009

“Pediatric Oral Medicine / Women’s Health and Dental Management of the Pregnant Patient”

During the first part of this course, Dr. Hupp will provide information pertaining to pediatric medical conditions, especially those that affect the provision of dental treatment. She will present and discuss modifications to dental treatment and/or to the patient’s medications.

The second part of this course will focus on women’s health, including osteoporosis and bisphosphonate-associated osteonecrosis. Dr. Hupp will also review dental management of the pregnant or breast-feeding patient.

Upon completion of this course, the participants will be able to:

- Evaluate the pediatric medical history
- Manage the prescription of medications for children
- Use established protocols for antibiotic premedication for cardiac and orthopedic conditions
- Understand the current “state-of-the-art” regarding osteoporosis and bisphosphonates
- Understand diseases that affect women differently than men
- Manage the dental treatment of a pregnant or breast-feeding patient
- Recognize the oral changes related to pregnancy
- Recognize the need for medical consultation and referral related to all of the above, and request the appropriate information from physicians



Dr. Wendy S. Hupp is an assistant professor of Oral Medicine and member of the Department of Diagnostic Sciences, Prosthodontics, and Restorative Dentistry at the University of Louisville School of Dentistry (ULSD). She is a graduate of the University of Pennsylvania School of Dental Medicine and practiced general dentistry in Wayne, Pennsylvania for nearly six years. Dr. Hupp completed her residency training in Oral Diagnosis, Oral Medicine, and Oral and Maxillofacial Radiology at the Naval Postgraduate Dental School in Bethesda, Maryland.

Dr. Hupp is a Diplomate of the American Board of Oral Medicine, and joined the ULSD Faculty in July, 2007. Dr. Hupp lectures nationally on the treatment of medically complex patients, pharmacology, HIV/AIDS, clinical oral pathology, and women’s health. Her most recent publications include the management of oral piercings, dental management of cancer patients, bisphosphonate-associated osteonecrosis, and pharmacology for dentists.

“Management of Head, Neck and Facial Pain”

Alan Stiles, D.M.D., is an Instructor in the Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at Thomas Jefferson University. His clinical practice is limited to the management of head, neck, and facial pain.

Dr. Stiles is a graduate of the University of Pittsburgh. He received his dental degree from Temple University School of Dentistry in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. He completed a residency in Orofacial Pain and Dysfunction at UCLA School of Medicine and Dentistry. He then completed his fellowship in headache at the Jefferson Headache Center in the Department of Neurology at Thomas Jefferson University in Philadelphia.

Dr. Stiles is an active member of the American Academy of Orofacial Pain and the American Headache Society. He is also a peer reviewer for *Headache: The Journal of Head and Face Pain and Cephalgia*.

Dr. Stiles’s publications include many peer-reviewed articles, book chapters, an Atlas of Migraine, and Clinical Manual of Trigeminal Neuralgia. His special interests include trigeminal neuralgia, migraine variants, and atypical trigeminal neuropathic pain syndromes.

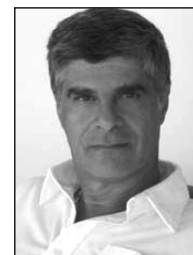
Seminar #4 Friday, April 16, 2010

Esthetic Integration of Digital-Ceramic Restorations on Implants and Natural Teeth

Today’s great challenge on teeth and implants is to develop **natural-looking and harmonious soft tissue that mimics that of the adjacent teeth**. Since implant treatments are presently biologically-driven we must consider the importance of tissue preservation to limit unaesthetic tissue remodeling around implants. Where deficiencies exist, hard and soft tissue regeneration/augmentation procedures are indispensable to avoid esthetic failures. Treatment predictability implies the understanding of biological parameters (including biotype) and thorough evaluation of the implant site.

The esthetic integration of Digital-Ceramic restorations is the primary objective clinically as well as physically, mechanically and biologically. Presently metal-free restorations combine strength, biocompatibility, esthetics and longevity and can be fabricated via CAD-CAM technology. Aluminum and zirconium oxides are the materials of choice for single and multiple crowns, three-quarter laminate veneers as well as fixed partial dentures. Their indications will be clearly defined during the presentation in order to avoid failures, and to reduce preparation invasiveness.

New developments on the Procera® system will be also described and illustrated with numerous clinical cases and videos emphasizing a contemporary digital esthetic dentistry.



Bernard Touati, D.D.S., M.S. is currently a visiting professor at Hadassah School of Dental Medicine in Jerusalem. He is a former assistant professor in Prosthodontics at Paris 5 University, past-president of the European Academy of Esthetic Dentistry and founder and past-president of the French Society of Esthetic Dentistry. He is a member of the American Academy of Restorative Dentistry and the American Academy of Esthetic Dentistry. Dr. Touati lectures internationally and he has authored numerous publications, including *Esthetic Dentistry and Ceramic Restorations*, (Martin Dunitz publishing), coauthor of *The Art of Smile*, (Quintessence) and *Integration of Digital Ceramic Restorations*, (Montage Media Publishing). He is editor-in-chief of *Practical Procedures and Aesthetic Dentistry*, and Co-Academic Director of the Global Institute for Dental Education.
