As a speaker and influencer in the dental community, Dr. Paul Goodman has been invited to present at a multitude of diverse events across the county, including the Dental Success Summit with Dr. Mark Costes, Voices of Dentistry in Arizona and the Greater New York Dental meeting. In February of 2017, Dr. Paul Goodman founded his company, Dental Nachos, and *Dr. Nacho* was born. Dr. Stout is a graduate of both Leadership Institutes of the Kellogg School of Management and the Wharton School of Business. She specializes in the care of infants, children, adolescents, and special needs patients and especially enjoys her relationship with many of the families that are part of the Trisomy 21 Program. *Dr. Stout has no relevant financial relationships to disclose.*

MARY PUGH received her bachelor's degree from Rosemont College, graduating summa cum laude. She received the Genevieve Blatt Award and Esther Sylvester Law School scholarship to Villanova Law School where she served as a member of the Law Review from 1985-1986. published over 130 referred papers and several book chapters. He has received over \$15 Million in research funding throughout his career.

Dr. Ismail has led the transformation of Temple University Kornberg School of Dentistry to become a vital player in the university's community engagement, research, and graduating clinical competent dentists. He has extensive experience working with faculty, several of the schools and colleges, and in working with all the service units. His quest for excellence with compassion and kindness has created an engaging and happy environment at the dental school among the majority of students, faculty, and staff. He is a lean manager who has been focused on the return of tuition funds to benefit the students and Temple University.

Dr. Ismail is a recognized leader in global education and in bridge building in areas of conflict such as between colleagues in Israel and Palestinian Authority. He collaborates with the American Jewish Committee to fight anti-Semitism.
